Community Pantry – APCM Report



Since launching the pantry last June the project has been generously supported by individuals and organisations across our community. Overall feedback has been very positive and many have commented that it has enhanced the profile of St Cuthbert's in the village

Food donated at the Harvest Festival provided a good foundation of essential items as we entered the autumn.

At Christmas our local schools collected more than 1,000 items and this combined with various chocolate treats and gifts meant we provided much needed help across our community for those facing the additional pressures and stresses of the winter months.



As well as the food donations we have been busy fundraising. A wreath making workshop at Christmas, a grant from the Miller Homes Community Fund and individual gifts and cash donations have raised over £1,250. The money has been used to buy tinned meat, fish, vegetables, fruit and soups and keep our shelves well stocked.
